Stay HANDS OFF and complete checklist. If safety concerns then state them clearly to team

| 5 | Drugs and fluids: double checked prior to administration | |
| Clinical Action Prompts | | |
| 1 | Desaturation <90% during laryngoscopy: "patient requires ventilation" | |
| 2 | Prolonged vascular access attempts: "consider intraosseous" | |
| 3 | Cardiac arrest (penetrating trauma to torso): "consider thoracotomy" | |
| 4 | Cardiac arrest (pregnant woman > 20 weeks): "consider hysterotomy" | |
| 5 | Physiological monitor vigilance: announce if not identified by team: | |
| | Loss of capnography | |
| | Change of cardiac rhythm | |
| | New hypotension (SBP < 105) | |
| | New threat of hypoxia (SpO2 < 92%) | |
| Prior to transfer | | |
| 1 | Tubes and lines secured | |
| 2 | Airway back up plan and equipment | |
| 3 | Battery sufficient: ventilator | |
| 4 | Battery sufficient: iv pumps | |
| 5 | Battery sufficient: monitor | |
| 6 | Analgesia, sedation, paralysis optimized / available | |
| 7 | Portable suction | |
| 8 | During transfer: Monitoring cables, iv lines, oxygen/ventilator tubing managed | |
